AMUSEMENT RIDE RE-CERTIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- The owner/operator needs to provide two copies of the final inspection report from the special inspection agency to Clark County's Building and Fire Prevention Bureau to perform amusement ride inspections must approve the special inspection agency. The report is to be signed and stamped by the principal of the special inspection agency (Nevada licensed professional engineer).
- The owner/operator will need to submit items 1 and this application to the Building & Safety Division through the online dashboard. Renewal fee and an administrative issuance fee are required at this time.
- The documents will go through a Structural review and a review by the City of Las Vegas Inspection Supervisor; and if approved, the owner/operator will be informed via email that the documents are ready for download; an inspection fee and possible additional plan review fees will have to be paid upon plan issuance. The owner/operator will schedule a 140 (final building inspection) and contact the area inspection supervisor to make an appointment to review the documents and sign off the inspection card.
- Once the inspection has passed, the certificate will be available for download online.

NOTE: RIDE CERTIFICATION RENEWALS ARE REQUIRED ON AN ANNUAL BASIS.
