Changes to the Building Permit Effective Monday, October 16, 2017

The City of Las Vegas Department of Building & Safety is making changes to the building permit to allow for electronic printing.

What is changing?

- Permits will no longer be on pre-printed card stock and instead will be on regular 8 1/2" x 11" size paper.
Inspections will no longer be listed on the permit, but the full list of inspections is still available on our website.

This will allow us to move towards faster printing in our offices and eventually allow for our customers to re-print from their offices. The new permit will look like this example:
