Exemption from the 2009 International Energy Conservation

Code (City of Las Vegas Ordinance No. 6256

BACKGROUND

On June 19, 2013, the City Council of the City of Las Vegas adopted Ordinance No. 6256 which became effective on June 23, 2013. This ordinance provides that "the conversion of a commercial building originally constructed before 2009, or any addition, alteration, renovation or repair thereto, need not comply with the minimum energy conservation standards of the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code if the original construction of the building and any subsequent addition, alteration, renovation or repair complied with any corresponding standards that were in effect at the time of the original construction or the subsequent addition, alteration, renovation or repair."

APPLICATION OF ORDINANCE

In order the apply the ordinance in a manner consistent with its intent, the Building & Safety Department has determined that any <u>commercial</u> building, either completed or a shell, that received Final Inspection approval on or before December 31, 2008 is exempt from compliance with the requirements of the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code (IECC). This exemption applies to any addition, alteration, renovation or repair to such buildings. Buildings under construction at the time of the effective date of the ordinance that had not yet received Final Inspection approval are required to be completed in accordance with the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code or the edition of the IECC in effect at the time of plan review approval as reflected on the approved plans. This exemption does not apply to residential buildings.
