



# New Online Building Permits

## *Industry Advisory from the City of Las Vegas Building and Safety Department*

Effective Oct. 7, 2013, the city of Las Vegas Department of Building and Safety will be launching a new online tool for issuing building permits on the web. The new system will allow homeowners and contractors to:

- Apply online for permits that do not require plans (water heaters; water softeners; electric meter tags; electric service changes; adding electric receptacles; gas meter tags; HVAC exact change outs; and construction trailers)
- Pay online for those permits
- Print the permit/inspection card for inspections
- Contractors will also be able to apply for multiple permits and pay for them in the same transaction (for example, water heaters at different addresses)
