**A-10 Contractor License Limitations**

Effective October 1<sup>st</sup> 2018 the City of Las Vegas Building and Safety Department will no longer issue permits to contractors licensed solely as an A-10 for work, which includes the installation of water or gas plumbing service lines to fixtures that are not directly related to the pool or pool service equipment. Examples of such fixtures include, but are not limited to fire pits, fireplaces, barbeque stub outs, and tiki torches. Any such water or gas plumbing work that exceeds the limitation of the scope of work defined in NRS 624.150 sub-classification A-10(F) must be performed by a properly licensed plumbing contractor.
