May 5, 2022**



City of Las Vegas and City of Henderson are proposing to adopt the 2021 International Building Code (IBC), International Fire Code (IFC) and International Wildland-Urban Interface Code (WUIC) by August of 2022. As a result, we are holding industry meetings to obtain feedback from our industry partners on the proposed adoption with local amendments.
