Updated Building Express Program

August 27, 2020

In an effort to update our building express program we are making the following modifications to the program effective September 14, 2020:

- In order to request an express appointment your plans must be submitted online and be routed for review. (This is similar to the Civil Express process)
- The express date if available will be set for the following week and the reviews will be completed by the express date.
- If there are questions regarding the comments an optional webex meeting with the plans examiners will be scheduled to go over the comments in a one on one setting.

We are hopeful that the above changes will help streamline the process and make it available to more projects.

In order to request an express appointment you will need to identify in your scope of work during your online submittal that you would like an express review if available. Once the Permit Technician has reviewed the project and if it is able to be routed for review they will contact you and let you know if an appointment is available.

Please note that there are no proposed changes to the Civil Express program at this time.
