

## Industry Advisory from the Building & Safety Department Adoption of the Updated 2018 Building Code Amendments April 5th, 2021

The City of Las Vegas Department of Building & Safety is pleased to announce that the City of Las Vegas City Council approved an update to the previously adopted amendments to the building codes, administrative code and Fee schedule, listed below, on February 3rd, 2021.

- 2018 International Building Code Amendments
- 2018 International Existing Building Code Amendments
- 2018 International Swimming Pool and Spa Code Amendments
- 2018 Uniform Mechanical Code Amendments
- 2018 Uniform Plumbing Code Amendments
- 2019 Administrative Code
- 2019 Fee Schedule

The updated amendments are currently effective with the following exceptions:

- 2019 Fee Schedule The new fee schedule will be effective starting July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. Any fees added to an application after this date will be subject to the new fee schedule
- FastTrack Program This program is not included in the 2019 Administrative code but will remain in effect until July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021. All water heaters installed after this date will need to pull a permit and schedule an inspection with City of Las Vegas Building and Safety Department. The permit can be applied online at one of the following links:
