



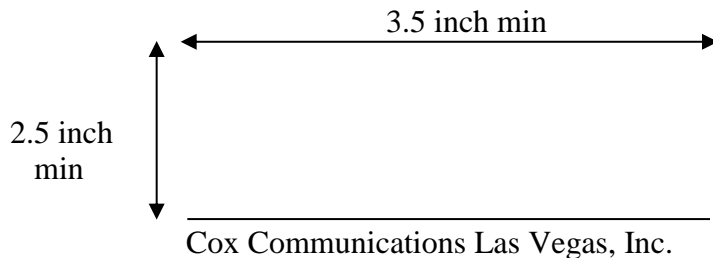

**Updates to Processes for Civil Improvement Plan
Final Signatures
March 22, 2022**

The City of Las Vegas Department of Building & Safety is pleased to provide updates to the process for obtaining final utility signatures on Civil Improvement Plans.

In our original announcement sent on Dec 23, 2021, we stated:

- Cox Communications provides an electronic approval so engineers no longer need to provide an approval block for Cox Communications.

To ensure that the approved record drawings that are available in the field are clearly marked with all approval stamps an approval block is required for Cox Communications. The approval block should match the details below.



Please note, Cox will No longer sign physical plans that are within City of Las Vegas jurisdiction. The only way to obtain their final signature is through submittal to City of Las Vegas.

We are still working with the other companies so all other utilities, at this time, will need to be obtained through the current process.
