Additional Notes

- A Revision/Replot fee will not be assessed for the cover sheet for the purpose of updating the revision grid.
- If the Professional Engineer proposing this revision is not the original Professional Engineer, he/she shall indicate that they are resealing for Rev # only, and/or sheet # only adjacent to their Seal on each sheet being revised. The cover sheet shall contain all the Seals of the Professional Engineer(s) who has taken responsible charge for any of the work in the set.
- For existing projects that already have revisions, go through all sheets and determine the highest numbered revision. For example, if sheet 4 (sheet with the most revisions of the set) has 2 existing revisions, the cover Revision Grid will start with Revision number 3.
