



CAN MY HOME BECOME A SHORT-TERM RENTAL?

You may be eligible for a short-term rental (STR) license, if...

- The homeowner lives on site during the guests' entire stay. This would need to be made clear to your guests when you advertise the rental.
- Is rented for no more than 31 days at a time.
- Has no more than three bedrooms at the property, which would include the homeowner's bedroom.
- Is located at least 660 feet from any other STR, as well as 2,500 feet from a resort hotel.
- Is in a zoning area that allows STRs.
- Has written permission from your homeowner's association, if applicable.
