# COMPLIMENTARY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMIT

## **Definitions:**

**Art Gallery** means a business establishment whose primary business is the display, exhibit and sale of fine art for purchase by the general public. For the purpose of this definition, "fine art" means:

a) A work of visual art such as a painting, sculpture, drawing, mosaic or photograph;

- b) A work of written art, such as calligraphy;
- c) A work of graphic art, such as an etching, a lithograph, an offset print, a silk screen, or any other work of like nature;
- d) A work in craft materials, including, but not limited to, clay, textile, wood, metal, plastic or glass; or
- e) A work in mixed media, which is a work that is any combination of the art media set forth in this definition.

**Barbershop or Cosmetology establishment** means any establishment that is licensed or required to be licensed pursuant to the provisions of NRS Chapter 643 or 664 and that offers barber or cosmetology services to the general public.

Bridal Shop means an establishment that primarily markets and sells clothing or products relating to brides or weddings.

# Professional business means a business which:

- a) Holds itself out as offering services regarding one or more of the professions regulated by a State regulatory body as defined in NRS 622.060 or by Nevada Supreme Court Rules; and
- **b)** Provides such services through the business' principals, professionals, or other qualified individuals under State law or Nevada Supreme Court Rules to provide such services.

**Suit Shop** means an establishment that primarily markets and sells tailored suits.

#### **RESTRICTIONS:**

- a) Only the OWNER may apply.
- b) Each principal is subject to finding of suitability by the Director. Complimentary Alcoholic Beverage Permit (Part 2)
- c) A security/alcohol control plan must be approved by the Director or designee.
- d) Alcohol may not be stored in a manner accessible or visible to customers.
- e) Fees cannot be charged directly or indirectly (no cover charges, tips or donations) for alcoholic beverages.
- f) Bar structures are not allowed. Due to health and building requirements, mixed cocktails are not allowed.
- g) One-time use containers must be used for alcohol consumption.
- h) Allows up to two complimentary alcoholic beverages (beer/wine/spirits) per customer per day.

### The undersigned agrees:

- 1) That a permit requires a finding of suitability by the Director, an application for which has been submitted with this application <a href="Complimentary Alcoholic Beverage Permit (Part 2)">Complimentary Alcoholic Beverage Permit (Part 2)</a>.
- 2) All employees serving alcoholic beverages must have Alcohol Awareness Cards. At least one owner or key employee found suitable under this permit application must be present if alcohol is being served to patrons.
- 3) A key employee must be assigned (if not the owner) and found suitable by the Director to supervise alcohol service (Responsible Party Acknowledgement Notice Form # PL233)
- 4) The applicant has read the requirements of <u>LVMC Title 6.50</u> and is aware of the rules and regulations for alcohol service in the State of Nevada and the City of Las Vegas and agrees to follow all such rules and regulations.
- 5) The applicant acknowledges that this permit does not allow the sale of any alcohol.
- 6) The applicant agrees that no charge for entry, no tickets and no fees may be accepted from guests for an event under this permit. The service of beer/wine/spirits must be complimentary.
