<b>Subject:</b> <b>Unusable Cannabis Policy for Cannabis Establishments</b>	
<b>Division:</b> <b>Business Licensing</b>	<b>Effective:</b> <b>February 11, 2021</b>

**Purpose:** Under Las Vegas Municipal Code 6.95.190, cannabis waste must be made unusable prior to it leaving a licensed cannabis facility. The purpose of this policy is to set forth guidelines for cannabis establishments to maintain waste manifest documentation for any marijuana rendered unusable.

**Scope:** This policy applies to City of Las Vegas cannabis establishments.

**Procedure:** Waste manifest documentation is required to be maintained and available for inspection upon request. This waste manifest must be contained in each Cannabis Waste Disposal Plan as part of the establishment's Environmental Plan and must include the following information:

- The reason why the cannabis is unusable or has expired.
- Quantity of unusable or expired cannabis.
- Verifiable inventory tracking information of each product.
- Date of expiration or date that the cannabis became unusable.
- The name of the employee who determined the expiration date or determined that the cannabis was unusable.
- Description of the approved method used to render the cannabis unusable.
- Date of disposal. An authorized disposal agency must pick up all waste within 30 days of expiration or determination that the cannabis is unusable.
- Two signatures of the cannabis establishment's employees who can verify each disposal date.
