

Dear Licensee,

Las Vegas municipal code 6.95.120 requires that each establishment have a live video feed that is accessible to authorized law enforcement.

(B)

A twenty-four-hour surveillance system is required to monitor the interior and exterior of a medical marijuana establishment, a live feed of which must be accessible to authorized law enforcement at all times, and in real-time.

(1)

All recorded images must clearly and accurately display the time and date. Time is to be measured in accordance with U.S. National Institute of Standards and Technology standards.

(2)

The surveillance system's data storage device must be secured on-site in a lock box, cabinet, closet, or secured in another manner to protect from employee or third-party tampering or criminal theft.

(3)

A sign must be posted in any customer areas that the customer is under video surveillance.

Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department is partnered with Milestone Systems, a surveillance software company, to provide access to allow a 24 hour surveillance system for all Las Vegas based medical marijuana establishments.
