Bill 91-18, Ord. 3571 adopted 5-1-91, outlines resignations, vacancies and reappointments
Ord. 3592, adopted 1991, Director of Leisure Services or authorized representative to serve as a voting member
Bill 2001-114, Ord. 5392, adopted 12-5-2001, increased membership from nine (9) members to twelve (12) members
Bill 2008-52, Ord. 6016, adopted 12-3-2008, transferred authority from the Director of Leisure Services to the City Manager to designate one representative of City staff to serve ex officio.
- TERM:** 4 years or until his or her successor is appointed and qualifies - Must fill unexpired terms. No member shall be reappointed more than once. Limited to 2 terms.
- APPOINTED:** 12 voting members as follows:
3 appt. by Mayor
6 (1 appt. by each Councilman)
2 appt. by the established Arts Commission
One member representative of City staff, appointed by the City Manager, or a designee, to serve as ex-officio
(Commission to consist of:
at least 1 but not more than 3 arts professionals
at least 1 but not more than 3 practicing artists.)
