**AUTHORITY:** Bill No. 2010-4, Ord. 6079 created a new Category 10, reduced Category 7 from 4 members to 5 and made changes.

**TERM:** 4 years

**PURPOSE:** Carry-on preservation activities in the City of Las Vegas for building, structures and places of historical and architectural significance.

**MEMBERS:** 13 members - 11 members appointed by the City Council; and Two ex-officio representatives: Director, Planning Department or designee, City of Las Vegas, and Director, Nevada State Museum and Historical Society or designee of State Historic Preservation Office.

**CATEGORY:**

- 9 DIRECTOR OF THE NEVADA STATE MUSEUM & HISTORICAL SOCIETY OR OTHER DESIGNEE OF STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE (ex-officio)
- 10 ARCHEOLOGICAL PROFESSION

**NOTES:** Must fill unexpired terms if appropriate.

Each member must have a demonstrated interest in or knowledge of:

- a) The history of the City of Las Vegas
- b) Design, architecture, real estate and other matters relevant to judging the economic and cultural value of particular historic preservation activities.

Under Ordinance 5043, the two (2) additional Historic Preservation Commission seats have initial term expirations of 12-31-2001

NO CITY FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENT due to adoption of Bill 2001-70, Ordinance 5346, adopted 8-1-2001. (State Financial Disclosure no longer required due to passage of AB611 during 1999 Nevada State Legislature stipulating uncompensated Commissions are no longer required to file State form.)

**NOTE:** Non-voting, ex-officio members, except when no quorum, may vote on Consent agenda and only to the extent necessary to create or maintain a quorum.

**MEETINGS:** 4<sup>TH</sup> Wednesday of each month at 12:00 P.M., except there is no meeting in November and December meetings are the 2<sup>ND</sup> Wednesday

**MEETINGS:** Six (6 Members) of the Commission constitute a quorum for the purpose of conducting business. A majority vote of members present, and voting, shall be necessary to approve any item of business. Any member shall have the right to make a motion except the Chair.
