Youth and adults will serve side-by-side and select exemplary proposals for funding. Board reviews YNAPP applications and recommends awards to the City Council. Service learning grants are offered to registered neighborhood association youth groups for neighborhood and community improvement projects.
- AUTHORITY:** Created by City Council action on 3-1-2000 and members appointed on 5-3-2000. By-laws adopted 3-1-2000. By-Laws Amended by City Council on 11-5-2003; By-Laws Amended by City Council on 10-7-2009 (changes creating alternate representatives, setting quorum and procedural changes).
