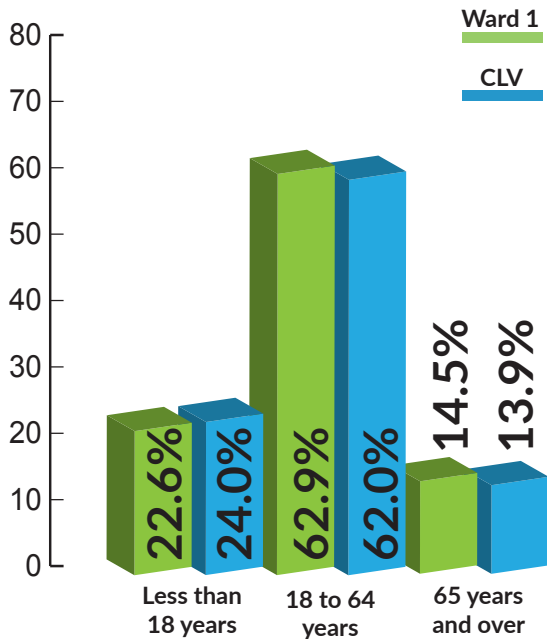

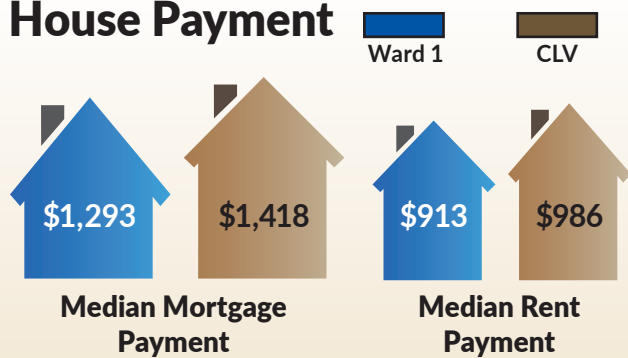


Mean Time Travel to Work Ward 1 - 21.9 minutes

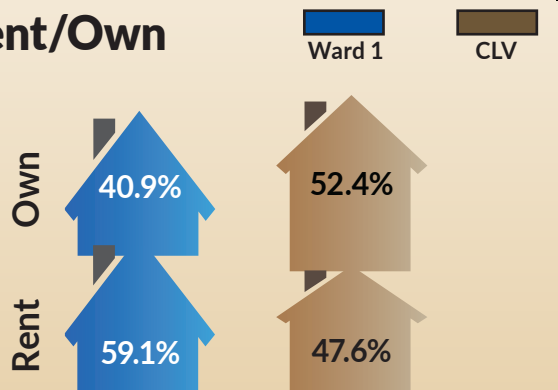


Mean Time Travel to Work CLV - 24.3 minutes

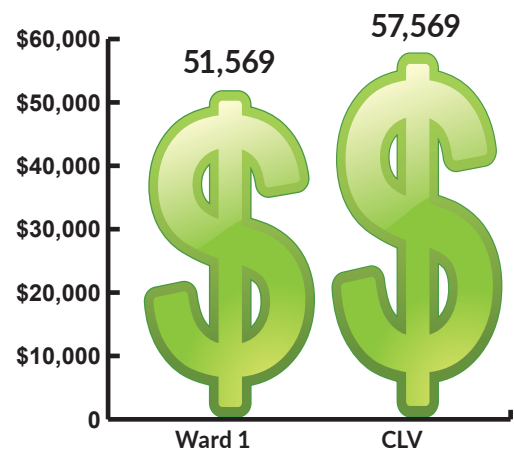

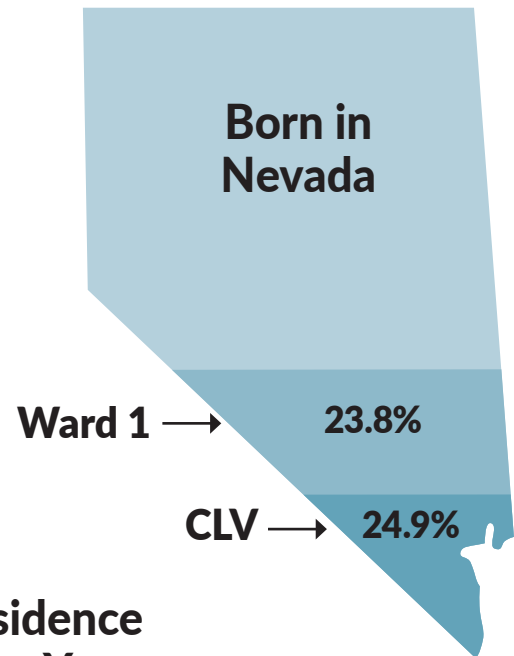
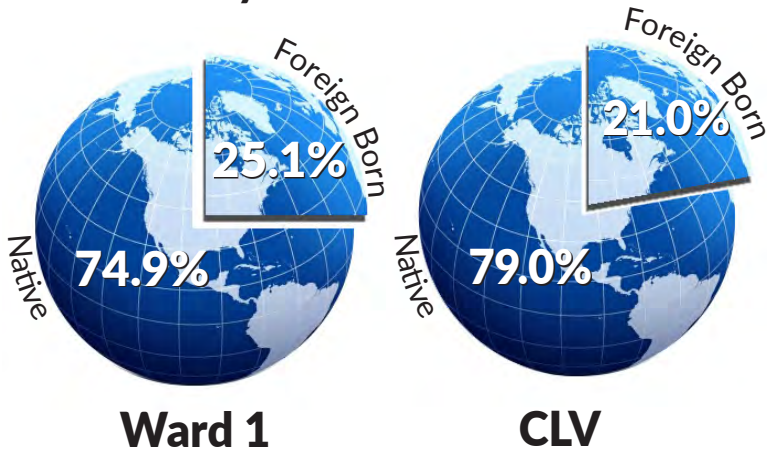


Individuals below Poverty Level Income

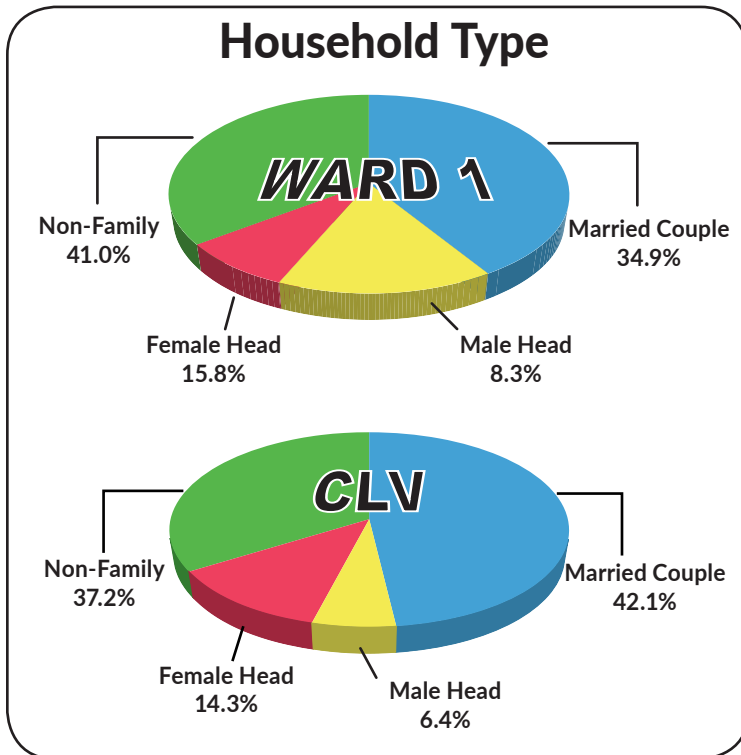

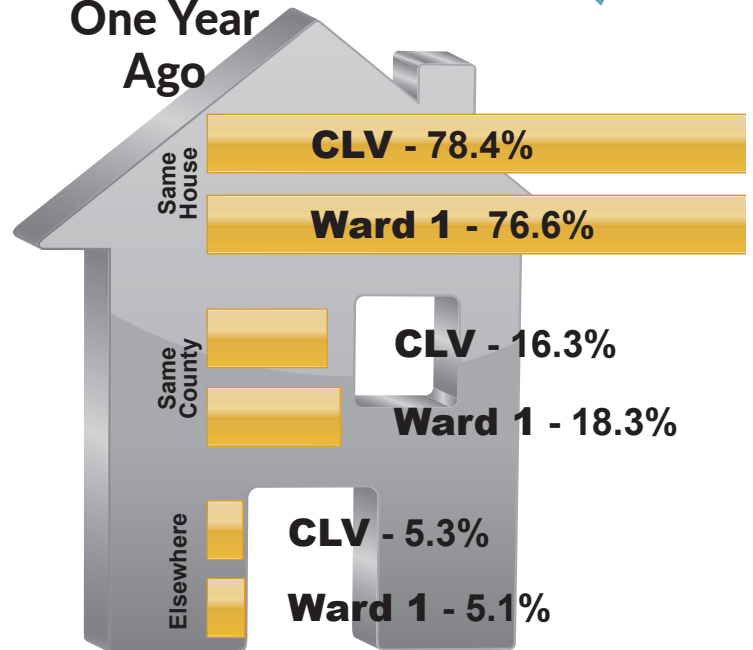
Nativity and Place of Birth
