RA-XX-2026 - Discussion for possible action regarding a Resolution finding the proposed changes to amend the Security Grant Incentive Program by the City of Las Vegas Redevelopment Agency (RDA) to include buildings without retail storefronts, and tattoo shops as an eligible business type, to be in compliance with and in furtherance of the goals and objectives of the Redevelopment plan and authorizing the approval of the changes by RDA - Redevelopment Areas 1 and 2 - Wards 1, 3 and 5 (Knudsen, Diaz, and Summers-Armstrong) [NOTE: This item is related to Council Item XX (R-XX-2026)]

**PURPOSE/BACKGROUND:**

This authorizes buildings without retail storefronts to be eligible for the program. Additionally, tattoo shops will now be an eligible business type. The Executive Director of the RDA was authorized on April 16, 2025, by RDA and City Council to execute Security Grant Program contracts, and/or approve disbursements of funds for individual grants of up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000). The delegation of grant approval and signing authority to the Executive Director for the execution of agreements and approval of grant disbursements will facilitate the timely and efficient administration of funds, eliminating the need for individual grant approvals by the Agency Board or City Council. The amended program will expand eligibility, with the goal of promoting economic stability in the Redevelopment Area.
