

911 Telephone Line Surcharge Ordinance

(Adopted by the Clark County Board of Commissioners on January 20, 2026)

Pursuant to NRS 244A.7643, Clark County has adopted an ordinance that imposes a 911 telephone line surcharge on all customers of telecommunication providers and suppliers of mobile telephone service. The funds will be used to maintain and enhance emergency communications and upgrade technology.

Beginning April 1, 2026, the following surcharge will be imposed on each access line, trunk line and mobile telephone number assigned to customers within Clark County (including the incorporated cities):

1. Fifty cents (50¢) per month for each access line to the local exchange of a telecommunications provider, which shall be increased annually on April 1st of each year by ten cents (10¢) up to the maximum of one dollar (\$1.00);
2. Five dollars (\$5.00) per month for each trunk line to the local exchange of a telecommunications provider which shall be increased annually on April 1st of each year by one dollar (\$1.00) up to the maximum of ten dollars (\$10.00); and
3. Fifty cents (50¢) per month for each telephone number assigned to a customer by a supplier of mobile telephone service within Clark County which shall be increased annually on April 1st of each year by ten cents (10¢) up to the maximum of one dollar (\$1.00).

Disputes related to the amount of surcharge on a customer's bill should be directed to the telecommunications provider or mobile telephone service supplier.
