



FIREFIGHTER TRAINEE RECRUITMENT

Minimum Requirements

The minimum requirements to apply for the position of Firefighter Trainee are listed below. Once your application has been reviewed, Human Resources will provide notification via e-mail whether or not you qualify for the NTN written test. Applicants with an NTN test score of **70% or higher** will then be invited to continue with the hiring process. Please see [Job Description](#) for detailed information regarding the position. Competition for Firefighter openings is extremely competitive, so preparation is crucial!

Minimum Requirements

- Must be 18 years of age on the date of application.
- Possession of a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Possession of a valid driver's license on the date of application.
 - *Must attach and clearly label attachments to your online (governmentjobs.com) application when you apply. Failure to attach required documents will result in your application not being considered. You will not be able to attach any documents after your application has been submitted.*
- Las Vegas Fire & Rescue (LVFR) is a full-service transport agency. Operations personnel are required to complete both suppression and EMS certification training in an academy setting and maintain proficiency thereafter. Possession of a current State of Nevada, Clark County OR National Registry Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) certificate and an Advanced-EMT (AEMT) certificate are desirable **but NOT required at the time of application**.

- Candidates must pass the Candidate Firefighter Written Exam ([NTN](#)) with a **70% or higher AND** pass the Firefighter Physical Assessment (includes Hex Deadlift, Power Throw, Hand Release Pushups, Sprint-Drag-Carry, Leg Tuck, and 1.5 mile run). This is a PASS or FAIL physical test. **Failing any one of the standards is considered a failure for the entire test.** Candidates will be limited to one (1) attempt for the Physical Assessment. - Updated verification of EMT certificate status will be required for any future academies from this recruitment.
