



# TITLE VI

## Notice to the Public

### **Your Rights Against Discrimination under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964**

The City of Las Vegas hereby gives public notice that it is the City's policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, the Civil Rights Restoration Act of 1987, and related statutes and regulations in all programs and activities. The City of Las Vegas operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age, and disability.

Any person who believes they have been aggrieved by an unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI has a right to file a formal complaint with the City of Las Vegas or the Nevada Department of Transportation. Any such complaint must be in writing and filed with the City of Las Vegas Title VI Coordinator/Human Resources Department within 180 days following the date of the alleged discriminatory occurrence.
