The U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) is considering a request for Federal assistance from the City of Las Vegas to construct a Medical Education and Training Center (METC) within the Medical District at the southeast corner of Shadow Lane and Wellness Road, Las Vegas, NV 89106, Assessor's Parcel Numbers 139-33-402-034, -014, and -015 comprising of 0.72 acres. The project is located within Township 20S, Range 61E, Section 33 in the city of Las Vegas, Clark County, Nevada. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), EDA is conducting an assessment of the potential of the proposed project to affect the environment and/or historic properties.

The project is a proposed 4 story, 34,000 square foot education and training facility with a childcare center, classrooms, labs, training rooms, and other student facilities. The project will be located across 3 separate parcels - 1707 Wellness Way, 1711 Wellness Way, and 801 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas NV 89106.
