POSITIONS*

POOL MANAGER: \$18 PER HOUR**

Must possess current certifications in Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED, Water Safety Instructor and Lifeguard Instructor. Must have some experience managing others.

LIFEGUARD/WSI: \$16 PER HOUR**

Must possess current certifications in Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED, and Water Safety Instructor. Must be 16-years-old.

LIFEGUARD: \$15 PER HOUR**

Must possess current certification in Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED. Must be at least 16-years-old.

ASSISTANT: \$14 PER HOUR

Primarily front desk attendants and locker room attendants. May possess CPR/AED, but not required. Must be at least 16-years-old. Computer experience highly desired.

LABORER: \$14 PER HOUR

No certification required. Performs facility maintenance duties prior to the pool opening. Must be a competent swimmer. Must be at least 16-years-old.

Bilingual applicants are encouraged to apply!

*East Side pool locations are eligible for incentive pay at an additional 50 cents an hour on all position starting rates. These rates apply at Doolittle, Municipal, CMDH and Baker Pools.

The city of Las Vegas will begin to hire staff for winter start dates in Jan. 2026 and will continue to hire throughout the spring and into the summer until all positions are filled for Spring/Summer start dates. FOR ALL CLASSES

REQUIREMENTS: Participants must pass pre-requisites on first day of class and **MUST ATTEND** each class session to obtain certification. No exceptions.

REFUND POLICY: No refunds are given if the participant fails the course or fails to show up. A \$45 partial refund only if participant fails pre-requisites. Class canceled if fewer than four registrants.

PREREQUISITES: Will be completed within the first hour of the first day of class. See specific class description for details.

BOOKS & MATERIALS: Participants can view manuals within eLearning online and will receive pocket mask on the first day of class. AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARDING (DEEP WATER) - BLENDED LEARNING

COURSE LENGTH:

- 23½ hours in class/water training
- 6 hours at home online training to be done before class

PREREQUISITES:

- Be at least 15 years old
- Swim 200 yards freestyle: 150 yard swim-continuous, 2 minute break without breath, 50 yard swim continuous.
- Timed Rotated Event: Swim 20 yards, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound brick, return to surface, swim with brick to starting point, exit water without ladder within 1 minute, 45 seconds.
- Instructor will email online learning link. Must be completed prior to the first day of class and screenshots of the completion on the final page should be provided.

CERTIFICATIONS:

- American Red Cross Universal Certificate for Lifeguarding (First Aid/CPR/AED), which is valid for 2 years.

BECOME A LIFEGUARD INSTRUCTOR

AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARDING INSTRUCTOR

COURSE LENGTH:

- 16 hours for Instructor and 5 hours for Basic Level certification
- 2 hours at home or online training to be done before class

PREREQUISITE:

- Be 17 years old and possess current American Red Cross Lifeguarding (First Aid/CPR/AED) certification.
- Successfully complete skill assessment scenario demonstrating skill competency to standard. Details will be provided in instructor email.
- Successfully complete skill practice and polish session demonstrating all skills to standard. Details will be provided in instructor email.
- Instructor will email online learning link. Must be completed prior to the first day of class and screenshots of the completion on the final page should be provided.

CERTIFICATIONS:

- American Red Cross Universal Certificate for Lifeguard Training Instructor which is valid for 2 years.

SAFETY TRAINING FOR SWIM COACHES

AMERICAN RED CROSS SAFETY TRAINING FOR SWIM COACHES IN-WATER SKILLS CERTIFICATION

COURSE LENGTH:

- 3 hours in water
- 3 hours at home online training to be done before class

PREREQUISITE:

- Be 25 years old.
- Register and complete the Swim Coaches Safety Training Course online at American Red Cross by visiting: <http://www.redcross.org/online-classes/online-training-for-swim-coaches-online-safety-course/RCW000012FAA.html>. Bring proof of completion to class.

CERTIFICATIONS:

- American Red Cross Universal Certificate for Safety Training for Swim Coaches which is valid for 2 years.

FEES:

- \$25 for online course paid to the American Red Cross
- \$60 for in-person skill class paid to city of Las Vegas.

AMERICAN RED CROSS LIFEGUARDING (DEEP WATER) RECERTIFICATION

- 9½ hours in-class/online training.

PREREQUISITE:

- Be at least 15 years old and possess current American Red Cross Lifeguarding (First Aid/CPR/AED) certification.
- Swim 200 yards freestyle: 150 yard swim-continuous, 2 minute break without breath, 50 yard swim continuous.
- Timed Rotated Event: Swim 20 yards, surface dive 7-10 feet, retrieve a 10-pound brick, return to surface, swim with brick to starting point, exit water without ladder within 1 minute, 45 seconds.
- Instructor will email online learning link. Must be completed prior to the first day of class and screenshots of the completion on the final page should be provided.

- Successfully complete skill practice and polish session demonstrating all skills to standard. Details will be provided in instructor email.
- Instructor will email online learning link. Must be completed prior to the first day of class and screenshots of the completion on the final page should be provided.
