*Each child under 7 years old or under 48" tall must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older at all times. One parent per child-no exceptions. All swimmers must wear suitable swim attire. No cut-offs, shorts with frayed edges, jean shorts, leotards, underwear, bras, thong bikinis, or t-shirts at any time. Young children must wear an approved swim diaper. Diapers may be purchased at the front desk. Only United States Coast Guard approved floatation equipment may be used as a floatation device in the pool.*

### LEARN TO SWIM LESSONS

*\*Free group swim lessons are available for children 4 years and under until grant funds are exhausted. Please see staff to utilize.*

*\*\*Grants available for 5-11 years that may waive the costs of lessons and/or splash sports programs. Please see staff for availability.*

#### PARENT & CHILD: \*

**Ages 18 months-3 years | Perquisites: Swim diaper, parent or guardian in the water**

Parent and Child aquatics teaches safety behaviors around the water and develops swimming readiness by leading parents and children in water exploration activities with the objective of having fun and becoming comfortable in, on, and around water. Classes focus on preparing children for the preschool and level courses through motor skill development, independent exploration, and water safety.

#### PRESCHOOL LEVEL 1\*

**Ages: 3 - 5 years**

Orients young preschoolers to the aquatic environment and helps them gain basic aquatic skills. Classes aim to make students feel comfortable in the water and enjoy the water safely. Students are taught water entry and exit, floating with support, breath control and submerging, changing position, movement on the front and back and water safety.

#### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Enter independently, using either the ladder, steps or side, travel at least five yards, submerge to mouth and blow bubbles for at least 3 seconds, then safely exit the water.
2. While in shallow water, glide on front at least two body lengths, then roll to back and float on back for 3 seconds, then recover to a vertical position.



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### PRESCHOOL LEVEL 2 \*

**Ages: 3-5 years | Prerequisites: Preschool Level 1 Exit Skills Assessment**

This class will give participants fundamental skills such as floating and basic forward movement without support. Participants perform skills at a slightly more advanced level and gain more independence on the front and back.

#### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT: CAN BE PERFORMED WITH ASSISTANCE

1. Glide on front at least two full body lengths, roll to back, float on back for 15 seconds then recover to a vertical position.
2. Glide on back for at least two body lengths, roll to front, then recover to a vertical position.
3. Swim using combined arm and leg actions on front for three body lengths, roll to back, float for 15 seconds, roll to front then continue swimming on front for at last three body lengths.

### PRESCHOOL LEVEL 3\*

**Ages: 3-5 years | Prerequisites: Preschool Level 2 Exit Skills Assessment**

This class will improve participants' coordination of arm and leg actions while moving. Participants will be able to perform basic aquatic skills with greater proficiency, for longer distances and time. Students will be introduced to jellyfish and tuck floats and changing direction while swimming. In addition, previously acquired water safety knowledge and skills are reinforced and expanded upon.

#### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT: WHEN STUDENTS PASS PS LEVEL 3, THEY ADVANCE DIRECTLY TO LEVEL 3.

1. Step from side into chest-deep water, push off the bottom, move into a treading or floating position for 15 seconds, swim on front for five body lengths, then exit the water.
2. Move into a back float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then recover to a vertical position.
3. Push off and swim using combined arm and leg actions on front for five body lengths, roll to back, float for 15 seconds, roll to front then continue swimming for five body lengths.

### COMBINED PRESCHOOL LEVELS\*

**Ages: 3-5 years**

During winter months and at outdoor small pools, levels will be combined. Please see the level description for skills and information about each specific level. Preschool Levels will include Preschool Levels 1, 2 & 3.



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### LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 1

**Ages: 6-11 years**

Intended for children who have little or no water experience. Orients participants to the aquatic environment and helps them gain basic aquatic skills such as water entry and exit, floating with support, breath control and submerging, changing position, movement on the front and back and water safety.

#### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Enter independently, using either the ladder, steps or side, travel at least five yards, bob five times then safely exit the water.
2. Glide on front at least two body lengths, roll to back, float for 5 seconds and recover to a vertical position, with assistance.

### LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 2

**Ages: 6-11 years | Prerequisites: Learn to Swim Level 1 Exit Skills Assessment**

This class will give participants success with fundamental skills such as submerging and basic forward movement on the front and back while performing them at a slightly more advanced level. Students will be introduced to jellyfish and tuck floats and changing direction while swimming. This level marks the beginning of independent swimming skills.

#### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Step from side into chest-deep water, push off bottom, move into a treading or floating position for 15 seconds, swim on front and/or back for five body lengths, then exit water.
2. Move into a back float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then recover to a vertical position.3. Push off and swim using combined arm and leg actions on front for five body lengths, roll to back, float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then continue swimming for five body lengths.

### COMBINED BEGINNER LEVELS \*\*

**Ages: 6-11 years**

During winter months and at outdoor small pools, levels will be combined. Please see the level description for skills and information about each specific level. Preschool Levels will include Learn to Swim Levels 1 & 2.



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### LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 3

**Ages: 6 - 11 years | Prerequisites: Learn to Swim Level 2 Exit Skills Assessment**

Participants learn to swim front crawl and elementary backstroke at the rudimentary levels and are introduced to the scissors and dolphin kicks. Participants learn the survival float and increase their treading water duration of time. Students will learn the rules for headfirst entries and begin headfirst entries from a seated position at poolside.

#### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Jump into deep water from the side, recover to the surface, maintain position by treading or floating for 1 minute, rotate one full turn then turn as necessary to orient to the pool exit point, level off, swim front crawl and/or elementary backstroke for 25 yards, then exit the water.
2. Push off in a streamlined position then swim front crawl for 15 yards, change position and direction as necessary, swim elementary backstroke for 15 yards, then exit the water.

### LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 4

**Ages: 6-11 years | Prerequisites: Learn to Swim Level 3 Exit Skills Assessment**

Participants will learn the arm actions to build the sidestroke and breaststroke at the rudimentary level. Participants will also learn the back crawl and butterfly at the rudimentary levels in addition to open turns at the wall.

#### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Perform a feet first entry into deep water, swim front crawl 25 yards, change direction and position as necessary and swim elementary backstroke for 25 yards.
2. Swim breaststroke for 15 yards, change direction and position as necessary and swim back crawl for 15 yards.
3. Submerge and swim a distance of three to five body lengths underwater without hyperventilating, return to the surface, then exit the water.

Combined Advanced Levels \*\*

**Ages: 6-11 years | Prerequisites: Learn to Swim Level 2 or 3 Exit Skills Assessment**

During winter months and at outdoor small pools, levels will be combined. Please see the level description for skills and information about each specific level. Advanced Levels will include Learn to Swim Levels 3 & 4.

### TEEN/ADULT LEVELS

**Ages: 12+ years**

These classes are intended for older teens and adults wishing to improve their knowledge of and skill in the water. Level 1 & 2 are combined in one class for participants with no water experience or fear of the water and those who have rudimentary proficiency in freestyle and backstroke, are comfortable in deep water, and can tread water. Participants will learn skills according to their swimming goals and abilities.

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### SPLASH SPORTS SAMPLER

Want to try them all? Don't know how to play? Aren't sure what you like? We'll teach you!! The Splash Sport Sampler program includes all practice sessions for the season, four sport competitions, and the Spirit Splash Night team event. Over 9 weeks of the summer season participants will learn all four splash sports (Swimming, Water Polo, Diving, and Artistic Swim) with each sport as a focus during dedicated practice weeks. Practices will take a recreation tone that welcomes social learning opportunities to teach teamwork, sportsmanship, and self-led goal setting that encourage participants to challenge their abilities and learn something new. Practices are structured to reinforce skill mastery while building swim technique and fitness over the entire summer season.

At the conclusion of each sport timeframe, participants will compete as a pool against other city of Las Vegas Splash Sport Sampler Pools! Competitions are optional but all participants are encouraged to participate and transportation assistance to hosting pools for competitions will be made available so all families can join the team. Participants are also eligible to attend and compete in two additional swim meets offered as part of the Splash Sport Swimming summer program offered at select pools with the city of Las Vegas.

Prior to the last sport competition, participants will celebrate their summer of fun and achievements at our annual Spirit Splash Night event. This event is reserved for Splash Sports Sampler and Splash Sport Team participants to prepare their team spirit banners for the end of summer competitions while enjoying water inflatables, yard games, and fun! It's sure to create some Bounce-tastic memories with the addition of our new inflatable water trampoline!

### SPLASH COMPETITIVE SWIMMING: WEEKS 1-3 | JUNE 8-26

Swimmers are divided into 3 workout groups for practices (beginner, intermediate, advanced) based on their current swim technique and distance endurance. They may advance in workout group as they gain abilities at any time during the program. Swimmers will learn, refine and compete using the four competitive strokes (Freestyle, Breaststroke, Butterfly, Backstroke) in individual and relay events representing their pool team earning both individual event and relay team finish plan ribbons as well as points toward their team score per swim meet. Swim meet team points are scored by meet and cumulative summer season to crown an individual meet pool champion and combined meets season champion pool! Splash Sport Sampler participants are eligible to attend and compete in CLV swimming events for all competitions (July 25, Aug. 8) offered throughout the summer in addition to their designated sport specific competitions.

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### **SPLASH WATER POLO: WEEKS 4-5 | JUNE 29-JULY 10**

Participants will be introduced to the exciting sport of water polo in a beginner-friendly practice structure. Focus will be on learning fundamentals of the game including passing, treading water and defensive skills while building confidence and endurance in the pool. For participants that are still building deep water endurance and confidence, floatation devices will be used to stay afloat. This program is a great way to stay active while developing sportsmanship and teamwork in a fun environment. Participants will compete in a round robin tournament style competition featuring two teams of 7 players competing to score by throwing a ball into the opponent's goal over four quarters with the highest team score determining the winner to advance.

### **SPLASH DIVING: WEEKS 6-7 | JULY 13-24**

Participants are introduced to fundamental skills in a safe, fun, and encouraging environment for all ages. During practices, they will learn basic body positions (tuck, pike, layout), pool-side safety, proper hurdle techniques, and fundamental entries. Key skills taught include forward/back jumps, fall-ins, and basic dives. During competition, divers compete individually by rotating turns to complete 4 dives scored by judges (coaches from our diving programs). Dive scoring is based on degree of difficulty determining the highest score available for the dive and judges award scores because of dive elements such as starting position, approach, hurdle, elevation, execution, and entry. Dive scores are cumulative individually and team overall with awards for place ranking at the conclusion of the competition.

### **SPLASH ARTISTIC (SYNCHRONIZED) SWIMMING: WEEKS 8-9 | JULY 27-AUG. 7**

Artistic swimming (formerly synchronized swimming) combines swimming, dance, and gymnastics, performed in water to music. Participants will be introduced to fundamental skills like sculling, basic figures, and eggbeater kicks. Practice will focus on building strength, flexibility, breath control, and precision while staying in time with music and teammates. Participants will learn a choreographed routine to perform at the All-City Artistic Swim Show to close out the summer competition season.

*For all Splash Sports, participants must be able to complete one length (25 yds) of front crawl unassisted, without support.*
