*\*Fees must be paid for entry by all persons regardless of intent to swim*

*Each child under 7 years old or under 48" tall must be accompanied by an adult 18 or older at all times. One parent per child-no exceptions. All swimmers must wear suitable swim attire. No cut-offs, shorts with frayed edges, jean shorts, leotards, underwear, bras, thong bikinis, or t-shirts at any time. Young children must wear an approved swim diaper. Diapers may be purchased at the front desk. Only United States Coast Guard approved floatation equipment may be used as a floatation device in the pool.*

## WATER EXERCISE CLASSES

You don't need to be a strong swimmer—or even know how to swim—to gain the health benefits from aquatic exercise! Water aerobics classes welcome everyone, regardless of swimming ability. Classes are designed for ages 10 & over. Youth participants in classes should demonstrate class participation as directed by the instructor throughout any class session and will not be permitted to free swim or be outside of designated class areas.

### KEY TIPS FOR GETTING STARTED

- **Get Medical Clearance:** Consult your doctor, especially if you have health conditions.
- **Safety First:** Always use non-slip water shoes to prevent slipping and falls.
- **Ideal Depth:** Position yourself in chest-deep water. This maximizes buoyancy—reducing weight on joints—while keeping your feet secure on the floor.
- **Start Simple:** Begin basic intensity exercise levels for each water movement and focus on correct form.
- **Hydrate Often:** Even though you are in water, you still sweat, so bring a water bottle to the pool deck.
- **Focus on Technique:** Stand tall, engage your core, and keep movements slow, allowing the water's natural resistance to work your muscles. Land on the balls of your feet, pressing through to your heel, when doing any jumping moves.

## CLASS FEES & PASSES

Single class program fee and monthly passes are valid at all city pools for any water exercise class offering.

Daily Drop Fee Per Class ..... \$3

1 month pass (unlimited classes) ..... \$20 *\*Pass will be valid for 30 days from date of purchase*

*Class fees & passes are for water exercise class participation only and are not valid for open swim hours, lap swim hours or event entry fees or registrations. Participants will need to purchase a pool membership pass or pay the daily entry fee for pool use outside of instructor led class sessions.*

### WATER AEROBICS SCHEDULE

Monday/Wednesday ..... 10-11 a.m. .... \$3 per day

### SHALLOW WATER EXERCISE CLASS

This shallow water workout emphasizes low-impact cardio and strength exercises that are perfect for individuals who don't exercise regularly or suffer from conditions such as arthritis. You will march, jog, kick, and jump your way through the water to improve and maintain cardiovascular fitness, muscular endurance and flexibility. The class instructor will provide multiple levels of intensity modifications for participants to exercise at their fitness level using various water exercise equipment aids to assist or challenge class attendees. Participants are encouraged to determine the appropriate intensity level for their fitness needs and discuss any goals and restrictions their medical doctor has recommended.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-ADULT PARTICIPANTS (UNDER 18 YEARS):

Non-adult participants will require guardian consent signatures to be completed prior to the first class. Signatures can be completed electronically online when purchasing the monthly unlimited class pass after adding the youth participant to a parent account. Per class fees will require an in person signature each payment transaction by a guardian via electronic point of sale signature collection. Please ensure a guardian is accompanying youth participants for per class fee payment if not using a pass to participate.

*Participants under the age of 15 must be accompanied by a guardian for each class session that remains within the facility.*

*Participants 15-17 may attend classes independently with consent signatures completed in advance for class participation.*

### PARENT & CHILD: \*

**Ages 18 months-3 years | Prerequisites: Swim diaper, parent or guardian in the water**

Parent and Child aquatics teaches safety behaviors around the water and develops swimming readiness by leading parents and children in water exploration activities with the objective of having fun and becoming comfortable in, on, and around water. Classes focus on preparing children for the preschool and level courses through motor skill development, independent exploration and water safety.

### ADAPTIVE PARENT & CHILD PRESCHOOL AGES TRANSITION: \*

**Ages 3-5 years | Prerequisites: Swim diaper, parent or guardian in the water**

Parent and Child aquatics teaches safety behaviors around the water and develops swimming readiness by leading parents and children in water exploration activities with the objective of having fun and becoming comfortable in, on, and around water. Classes focus on preparing children for the preschool and level courses through motor skill development, independent exploration, and water safety. Adaptive Preschool transition is for students with adaptive support needs that may not be ready for a group setting without an aide/parent/guardian in the water. Continued focus on motor skill development, independence, readiness for group instruction and water safety.

### PRESCHOOL LEVEL 1\*

**Ages: 3-5 years**

Orients young preschoolers to the aquatic environment and helps them gain basic aquatic skills. Classes aim to make students feel comfortable in the water and enjoy the water safely. Students are taught water entry and exit, floating with support, breath control and submerging, changing position, movement on the front and back and water safety.

### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Enter independently, using either the ladder, steps or side, travel at least five yards, submerge to mouth and blow bubbles for at least 3 seconds, then safely exit the water.
2. While in shallow water, glide on front at least two body lengths, then roll to back and float on back for 3 seconds, then recover to a vertical position.

## PRESCHOOL LEVEL 2 \*

**Ages: 3-5 years | Prerequisites: Preschool Level 1 Exit Skills Assessment**

This class will give participants fundamental skills such as floating and basic forward movement without support. Participants perform skills at a slightly more advanced level and gain more independence on the front and back.

### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT: CAN BE PERFORMED WITH ASSISTANCE

1. Glide on front at least two full body lengths, roll to back, float on back for 15 seconds then recover to a vertical position.
2. Glide on back for at least two body lengths, roll to front, then recover to a vertical position.
3. Swim using combined arm and leg actions on front for three body lengths, roll to back, float for 15 seconds, roll to front then continue swimming on front for at least three body lengths.

## PRESCHOOL LEVEL 3\*

**Ages: 3-5 years | Prerequisites: Preschool Level 2 Exit Skills Assessment**

This class will improve participants' coordination of arm and leg actions while moving. Participants will be able to perform basic aquatic skills with greater proficiency, for longer distances and time. Students will be introduced to jellyfish and tuck floats and changing direction while swimming. In addition, previously acquired water safety knowledge and skills are reinforced and expanded upon.

### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT: WHEN STUDENTS PASS PS LEVEL 3, THEY ADVANCE DIRECTLY TO LEVEL 3.

1. Step from side into chest-deep water, push off the bottom, move into a treading or floating position for 15 seconds, swim on front for five body lengths, then exit the water.
2. Move into a back float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then recover to a vertical position.
3. Push off and swim using combined arm and leg actions on front for five body lengths, roll to back, float for 15 seconds, roll to front then continue swimming for five body lengths.

## LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 1

**Ages: 6-11 years**

Intended for children who have little or no water experience. Orients participants to the aquatic environment and helps them gain basic aquatic skills such as water entry and exit, floating with support, breath control and submerging, changing position, movement on the front and back and water safety.

### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Enter independently, using either the ladder, steps or side, travel at least five yards, bob five times then safely exit the water.
2. Glide on front at least two body lengths, roll to back, float for 5 seconds and recover to a vertical position, with assistance.

## LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 2

**Ages: 6-11 years | Prerequisites: Learn to Swim Level 1 Exit Skills Assessment**

This class will give participants success with fundamental skills such as submerging and basic forward movement on the front and back while performing them at a slightly more advanced level. Students will be introduced to jellyfish and tuck floats and changing direction while swimming. This level marks the beginning of independent swimming skills.

### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Step from side into chest-deep water, push off bottom, move into a treading or floating position for 15 seconds, swim on front and/or back for five body lengths, then exit water.
2. Move into a back float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then recover to a vertical position.3. Push off and swim using combined arm and leg actions on front for five body lengths, roll to back, float for 15 seconds, roll to front, then continue swimming for five body lengths.

## LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 3

**Ages: 6-11 years | Prerequisites: Learn to Swim Level 2 Exit Skills Assessment**

Participants learn to swim front crawl and elementary backstroke at the rudimentary levels and are introduced to the scissors and dolphin kicks. Participants learn the survival float and increase their treading water duration of time. Students will learn the rules for headfirst entries and begin headfirst entries from a seated position at poolside.

### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Jump into deep water from the side, recover to the surface, maintain position by treading or floating for 1 minute, rotate one full turn then turn as necessary to orient to the pool exit point, level off, swim front crawl and/or elementary backstroke for 25 yards, then exit the water.
2. Push off in a streamlined position then swim front crawl for 15 yards, change position and direction as necessary, swim elementary backstroke for 15 yards, then exit the water.

## LEARN TO SWIM LEVEL 4

**Ages: 6-11 years | Prerequisites: Learn to Swim Level 3 Exit Skills Assessment**

Participants will learn the arm actions to build the sidestroke and breaststroke at the rudimentary level. Participants will also learn the back crawl and butterfly at the rudimentary levels in addition to open turns at the wall.

### EXIT SKILLS ASSESSMENT:

1. Perform a feet first entry into deep water, swim front crawl 25 yards, change direction and position as necessary and swim elementary backstroke for 25 yards. 2. Swim breaststroke for 15 yards, change direction and position as necessary and swim back crawl for 15 yards.
3. Submerge and swim a distance of three to five body lengths underwater without hyperventilating, return to the surface, then exit the water.

## TEEN/ADULT LEVELS

**Ages: 12+ years**

These classes are intended for older teens and adults wishing to improve their knowledge of and skill in the water. Level 1 & 2 are combined in one class for participants with no water experience or fear of the water and those who have rudimentary proficiency in freestyle and backstroke, are comfortable in deep water, and can tread water. Participants will learn skills according to their swimming goals and abilities.

## AMERICAN RED CROSS CLASSES FOR CERTIFICATION

Classes for certification are offered throughout the year in American Red Cross Aquatics Programs for Lifeguarding, Lifeguarding Instructor, Water Safety Instructor, and Lifeguarding Review. Refer to the Aquatic Training and Employment Opportunities brochure for a full class schedule and information. Prospective employees for all city of Las Vegas pool locations registering for Lifeguard Training must register in person for a waiver of the full class fee. Application for employment and screening will begin during class.

## LIFEGUARD CERTIFICATION | \$160

This class is intended for anyone seeking certification for the first time, previously certified candidates that have expired, and candidates that may possess a certification from another certifying organization or shallow water/attendant certification that is current and wish to bridge to a full lifeguarding certificate. Participants must pass all pre-requisites on the first day of class, attend all class sessions, and complete all online learning content, in person skills and testing in accordance with the minimum certification requirements of the American Red Cross to gain certification at completion of the course.

Certification is valid for 2 years and includes Lifeguarding, CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid. Participants must be 15 years old on the first day of class. Pre-requisite skills will be tested on the first day of class and include:

1. Swim-Tread-Swim: *\*Candidates may swim using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both, but swimming on the back or side is not allowed. Swim goggles may be used.*
  - Swim 150 yards, continuously demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing with face in the water.
  - Tread water for 2 minutes, using only the legs.
  - 50 yards, continuously demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing with face in the water.
2. Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds: *\*Swim goggles may not be used.*
  - Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. Swim goggles are not allowed.
  - Surface dive, feet-first or headfirst, to a depth of 7 to 10 feet to retrieve a 10-pound object.
  - Return to the surface and swim 20 yards on the back to return to the starting point with both hands holding the object and keeping the face at or near the surface so they are able to get a breath.
  - Exit the water without using a ladder or steps.
