Boy Scout Swim Test

The Boy Scout swim test is required for ALL Scouts who will be attending Boy Scout Camp during the summer. Boy Scouts will be briefed in classroom setting then will be required to swim the test. Testing begins in April and goes through July. Tests can also be set up for an individual troops on a as need basis. Please call Kelly King at 702-229-4726 to set up a private testing.

The test consists of: "Jumping feet first into water over the head in a depth, level off, and begin swimming. Swim 75 yards in a strong manner using one or more of the following strokes: sidestroke, breaststroke, trudgen, or crawl (no dog-paddle); then swim 25 yards using an easy, resting backstroke. The 100 yards must be completed in one swim without stops and include at least one sharp turn. After completing the swim, rest by floating for one minute." Certified American Red Cross Lifeguards will sign off & provide the Boy Scouts of America Swim Test Certification certificate.
