Multi-Family Residential Addressing System

Important Things to Know:

- Official addresses will be assigned by the City of Las Vegas Department of Planning in accordance with Title 19.04.050 of the Unified Development Code. Property owners do not have vested rights to street names, address numbers or suite numbers, even if an address has been used for many years.
- All multi-family residential developments are assigned one address, referred to as the “Master Site Address or General Address”. Individual addresses for multiple buildings are not acceptable for new construction.
- All buildings within the development shall have a numerical designation starting at the primary entrance and continuing in a counterclockwise direction, beginning with number one.
- When there are 99 or fewer units, apartment numbers must be in the “100s” format. If there are more than 100 units, a “1000s” format shall be used. No alphabetical apartment designators are allowed (except for below grade units).
- The first digit of an apartment must always be the number of the floor on which the apartment is situated.
- Apartment numbering does not restart for each individual building.
