	<p>The Nevada Test Site Historical Foundation operates the National Atomic Testing Museum whose mission is to preserve and foster public accessibility to the history associated with the Nevada Test Site and the nation's nuclear weapons program. Between the years 2009 and 2012 the Centennial Commission awarded funding for the following projects at the museum.</p> <p>A grant of \$5,476 (2009) contributed to the costs of the Nevada Day Celebration on October 30, 2009, including a historic reenactment of pioneer Helen J. Stewart portraying life in early Las Vegas. A grant of \$50,000 (2010) funded "Building Atomic Vegas," an interactive exhibit which detailed the interconnection between the development of the historic Nevada Test Site and the growth of Las Vegas.
