	<p>Clark County marked its centennial in 2009 with a series commemorating its cultural and historic significance. The Centennial Commission awarded a \$100,000 grant to various project costs. These included historic markers and plaques for Blue Diamond, Indian Springs, Goodsprings School, Camp Lee Canyon, Whitney, Clark County Courthouse, and the Welcome to Fabulous Las Vegas Nevada sign. Other project costs included the exhibit in the restored Candlelight Wedding Chapel at Clark County Museum, design and printing of the book <i>Asphalt Memories: Origins of Some of the Street Names of Clark County</i>, and a Clark County float in the annual Hellsdorado parade.</p> <p>An additional grant of \$2000 funded transcription and materials of an oral history conducted by Blue Diamond History Committee.</p>
