



## Historic structures of Floyd Lamb Park at Tule Springs

	<p>The City of Las Vegas received a series of Centennial Grants funding the planning and preservation of historic structures of Floyd Lamb Park at Tule Springs. One of the city's oldest historic sites, Tule Springs Ranch was placed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1981, and the Las Vegas Historic Property Register in 2008.</p> <p>A grant of \$75,000 (2008) was used to hire HHM Inc, a historic preservation consulting firm, to complete an evaluation and building conditions assessment report of all structures on the property. A grant of \$200,000 (2009) contributed to the restoration of the Foreman's House for use as a Visitor Center. A grant of \$21,150 (2011) funded structural analysis and preservation plans for the park's Old Adobe Hut.
