



## Historic Preservation Commission Funding

	<p>The Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial provides funding to the city's Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) for its various preservation projects and programming. The funding assists with the costs of conducting historic resource inventories and surveys, the production of literature related to historic preservation, the manufacture of historic plaques and markers, membership fees for professional historic preservation organizations, as well as a small grants program to help owners maintain their historically listed properties.</p> <p>The City of Las Vegas created the HPC in 1991 to advise the City Council and Planning Commission on matters relating to historic preservation. The city's Historic Preservation Officer manages the Commission to oversee preservation activities for buildings, structures and places of historical and architectural significance. They also review historic designation applications to the National Register of Historic Places and the city's Historic Property Register.</p>
