	<p>The Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial granted \$236,160 to the Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County for the costs associated with producing a documentary film titled, <i>The Story of KCEP: The Little Station that Could... Not Stop</i>.</p> <p>The film recounts the 50-year history of Las Vegas's first black radio station, KCEP 88.1 FM, and the effect it had on the Black community in the Historic Westside. The film also highlights impactful national events that parallel the histories of the city of Las Vegas and KCEP.</p> <p>The documentary premiered on Feb. 28, 2024, and was aired for several community events through April 2024. A copy of the film was also provided to the city.</p>
