	<p>La Concha Motel, designed by Paul R. Williams Associates, opened in 1961 with a lobby of thin-shell concrete construction which has remained among the most elegant examples of mid-century architecture in Las Vegas. After the motel's closure in 2003 the building was donated to the Neon Museum.</p> <p>The Centennial Commission awarded several grants to the museum to preserve and adapt the building for use as the Neon Museum Visitor Center. In 2006, 2007, 2010, and 2011 awards provided for the assembly and relocation of the building to the museum site, restoring and reconstruction of the building, construction of an addition to the La Concha, electrical work, supplemental hardware, research, writing, tour-development and staffing for the museum. A grant in 2023 provided for lobby repairs and maintenance.</p> <p>https://neonmuseum.org/</p>
