	<p><u>Springs Preserve</u> is a 180-acre cultural institution listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1978. The site, known as the “birthplace of Las Vegas,” served as the original source of water for Native people in the Las Vegas Valley. Las Vegas Valley Water District owns and operates Springs Preserve, and Springs Preserve Foundation is its non-profit governing board.</p> <p>The Centennial Commission has awarded several grants to Springs Preserve, including the following for events.</p> <p>\$4,000 (2009) contributed to the Springs Preserve’s annual Culture and History Fair on May 9th, 2009. The funds contributed to supplies for educational activities inspired by the cultural history of Las Vegas.</p> <p>\$26,500 (2011) funded a photo contest commemorating Las Vegas history and cultural heritage, and archeological/historical educational offerings.</p>
