	<p>The pylon sign of the Stardust Hotel & Casino was designed, fabricated, and installed in 1968 by Ad-Art Sign Co. The sign proved to be one of the recognizable and celebrated neon landmarks of Las Vegas. The sign was in use until the Stardust closed in 2007.</p> <p>With the resort slated for demolition, its pylon sign was donated to the Neon Museum. The Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial awarded \$88,385 to the museum for the loading, transport, and unloading of the sign pieces from the Stardust (3000 Las Vegas Blvd. South) to the Neon Museum (700 Las Vegas Blvd. North).
