The former Courthouse and U.S. Post Office located at 300 Stewart Ave. was built by the federal government in 1933 and was listed on the National Register of Historic Places in 1983. The U.S. government deeded the structure to the city of Las Vegas for \$1 in 2000 with the stipulation that it be used for cultural activity. Funding from the Centennial Commission between 2006 and 2010 contributed to the restoration of the building for use as The Mob Museum.

The Centennial Commission awarded funding in the amount of \$291,850 for a full-length documentary film on the history of the U.S. Post Office and Courthouse and The Mob Museum. *This Building of Ours: The Story of a Las Vegas Landmark* was produced by Boyd Productions and released on July 16, 2024.
