| | <p>Harrison's Guest House, at 1001 F Street, is named for Genevieve Harrison who operated it as a boarding house for African American entertainers, travelers and divorcees from 1942 to 1957. Harrison's Guest House is listed on the Las Vegas Historic Property Register, the Nevada State Register of Historic Places, and the National Register of Historic Places.</p> <p>The Centennial Commission awarded a grant of \$17,500 in 2014 for the costs associated with infrastructure upgrades, and a grant in the amount of \$25,000 in 2020 was for restoration of exterior elements of the house.</p> <p><u>Harrison's Guest House, National Register of Historic Places Registration Form</u></p> |
