	<p>The Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial granted funding in the amount of \$65,000 to hire Northwind Resources Consulting, a professional cultural resource management firm, to complete a comprehensive windshield survey and National Register of Historic Places eligibility assessment of Tract Nos. 1–5 of the Huntridge Neighborhood with homes constructed between 1942 and 1947.</p> <p>The results of the survey found that commercial properties that were originally single-family dwellings are not eligible for listing, 11 individual residential properties are eligible as examples of residential WWII era housing in Las Vegas, and Tract No. 2 is recommended eligible as a historic district for its collection of homes constructed during the WWII era in the Minimal Traditional and Ranch styles.</p>
