| | <p>The Centennial Commission granted funding in the amount of \$46,000 to the Las Vegas High School Alumni Association to work with an architecture firm to produce a Historic Assessment & Feasibility Study of the school campus. The study includes a history of the school, an analysis of current building conditions and proposed plans for future use of the campus.</p> <p>The study was used as a tool and a reference to guide the Clark County School District in developing a master plan for the complex to ensure educational adequacy while preserving the historic architecture of the campus. Las Vegas High School, opened in 1930, is the oldest existing high school complex in the Las Vegas Valley.
