	<p>The Commission for the Las Vegas Centennial awarded a \$50,000 grant to the UNLV Oral History Research Center for a project entitled Latinx Voices in the Las Vegas Valley.</p> <p>The project entailed collecting audio and video recorded interviews with people who provided first-hand testimonies and personal photographs commemorating their life in Las Vegas. The interviewees provided their recollections of a wide variety of topics including, immigration and settlement, aspirations and challenges, family life, employment and economic issues, religion and culture, gender, neighborhoods and businesses, politics, social and community events, discrimination and activism.
