



## Neon Museum Deed and Expansion

|                     | <p>The Neon Museum, 770 Las Vegas Boulevard North, opened to the public in 2012. During the museum’s first ten years, the Centennial Commission awarded three separate grants funding improvements to its layout, design, and experience.</p> <p>A grant of \$64,156 (2013) funded the temporary removal of the museum’s sign collection for the installation of a geotextile fabric and chat landscaping to the outdoor museum grounds, which helped support the weight of the signs. A grant of \$425,000 (2016) contributed to the cost of purchasing the quarter-acre property at 714 Las Vegas Boulevard North, which was used for museum expansion. This expansion also improved visibility of the museum’s historic La Concha Visitor Center. A grant of \$76,108.71 (2021) contributed to the construction, materials, and electrical costs of upgrading the Brilliant! exhibit in the museum’s North Gallery.</p> <p><a href="https://neonmuseum.org/">https://neonmuseum.org/</a></p> |
