



Historic Neon Signs for Project Enchilada

	<p>The Centennial Commission granted \$762,000 for the restoration or rebuilding of several Fremont Street neon signs. The effort was a component of the city's <u>Project Enchilada</u> which sought to bring illumination and overall stabilization to East Fremont Street.</p> <p>The 1950s-1960s era signs were each on the property of former, closed motels which reflected Fremont's history as a busy tourist byway. The properties were owned by subsidiaries of DTP Companies. The original, circa 1951 sign of Lucky Motel (1111 Fremont St.) was acquired from a private collection and re-installed at the motel site. The signs of Las Vegas Motel (1200 Fremont), Fremont Motel (1208 Fremont), Star View Motel (1217 Fremont) and The Gables Motel (1301 Fremont) were restored and/or completely rebuilt. The effort was completed in 2021.</p>
