	<p>Friends of Red Rock Canyon, a Nevada nonprofit organization based in Blue Diamond, Nevada, was awarded a Centennial grant in the amount of \$9,867 to complete, publish, promote and distribute 500 copies of the book entitled <i>Seekers, Saints and Scoundrels: The Colorful Characters of Red Rock Canyon</i>.</p> <p>The book covers one hundred and seventy-five years of exploration and development. Explorers, cowboys, miners, conservationists and others who have left their mark on the area are highlighted in the history of the Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area. The book also discusses the history of Spring Mountain Ranch, Bonnie Springs, and other ranches and settlements in the area.
