	<p>Springs Preserve is an 180-acre cultural institution listed on the National Register of Historic Places since 1978. The site, known as the “birthplace of Las Vegas,” served as the original source of water for Native people in the Las Vegas Valley. Las Vegas Valley Water District owns and operates Springs Preserve, and Springs Preserve Foundation is its non-profit governing board.</p> <p>The Centennial Commission has awarded several grants to the Springs Preserve including the following for equipment.</p> <p>\$50,000.00 (2012) for the purchase of a 48-seat trackless train used to transport visitors around the Springs Preserve.</p> <p>\$32,840.00 (2015) to purchase and install an interpretive ramada and fabricate interpretive panels along the Exploration Trail on the Springs Preserve.</p> <p>https://www.springspreserve.org/</p>
