The Centennial Commission awarded \$49,400 to UNLV University Libraries Special Collections in order to digitize original and microfilmed newspapers from the early years of Las Vegas' history.

Las Vegas Age newspaper, published from 1905-1947, and the Las Vegas Times, the city's first newspapers published from 1905-1906, were made available to the public through the [UNLV Special Collections portal](#) and the Library of Congress Chronicling America website. The thousands of pages of these papers were also, for the first time, available in searchable text format. Previously, researchers could only access this material by viewing original or microfilmed versions in person at UNLV's Lied Library or the Nevada State Museum.
