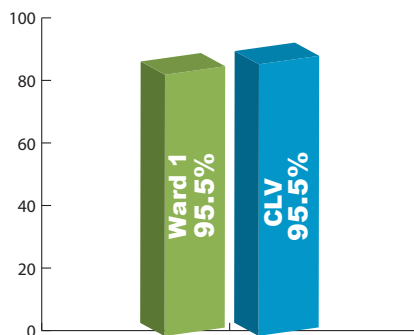

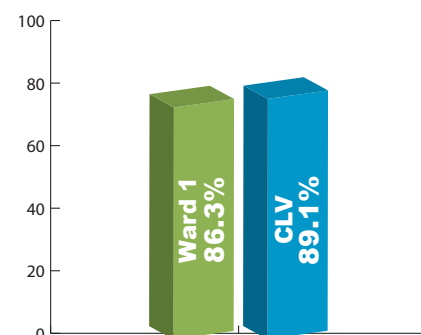


Computers and Internet Use

Households with a Broadband Internet Connection

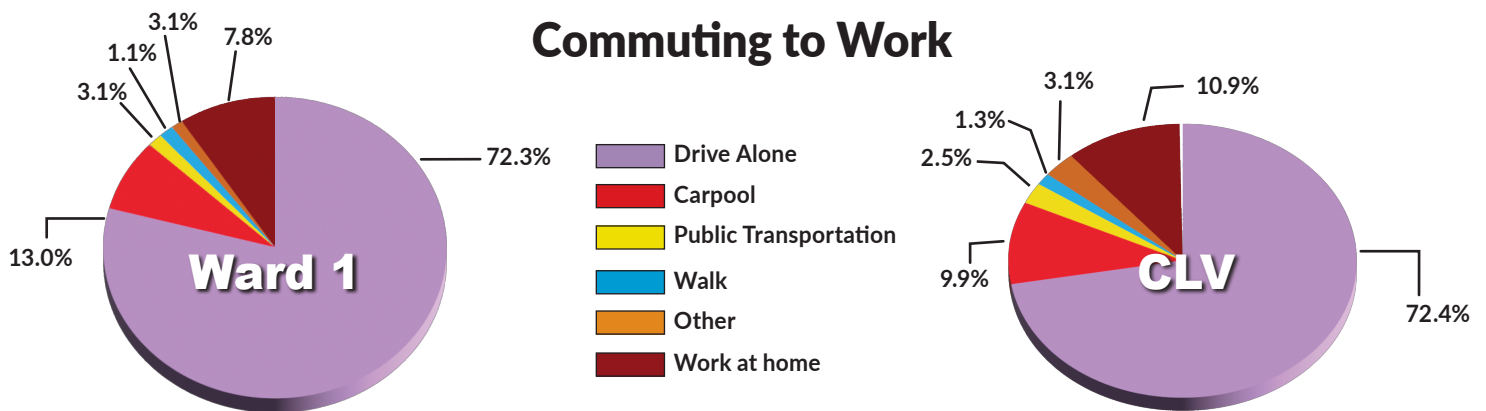

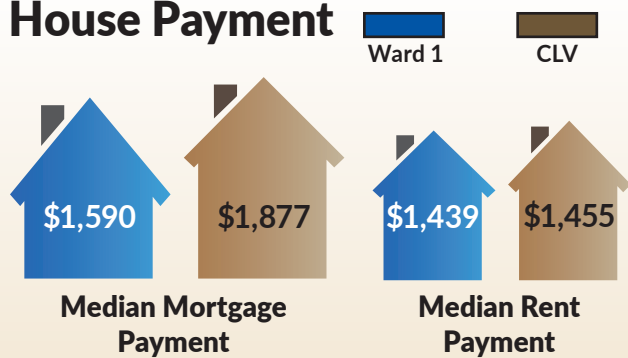
Vehicles Available per Household



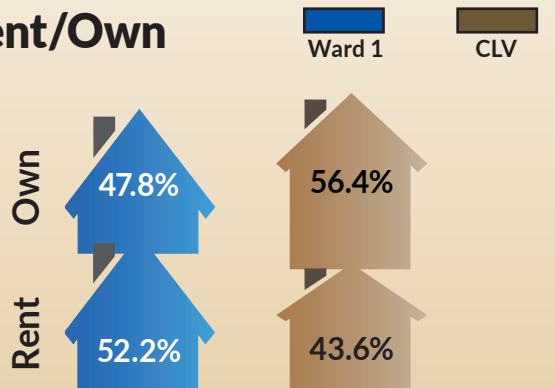

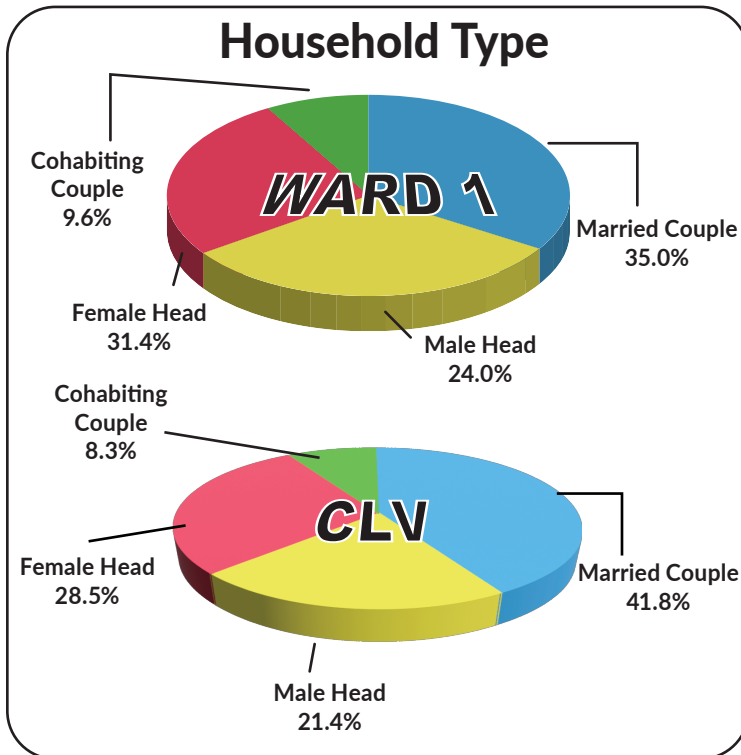
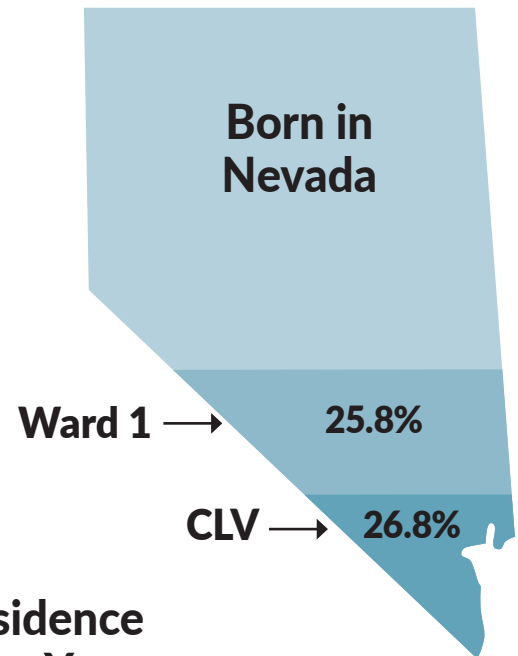
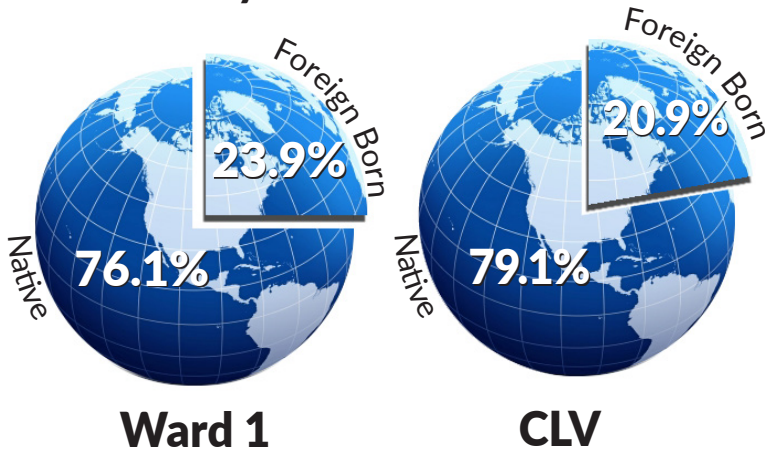


Individuals below Poverty Level Income

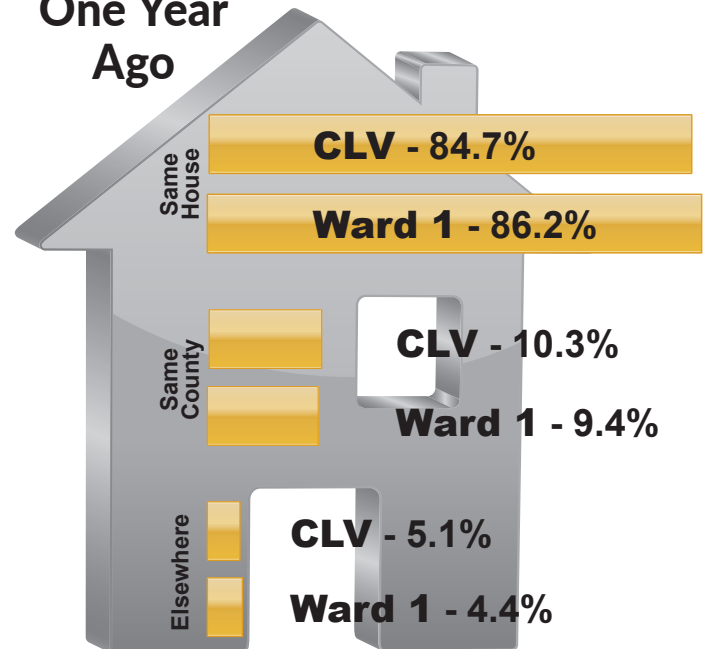
