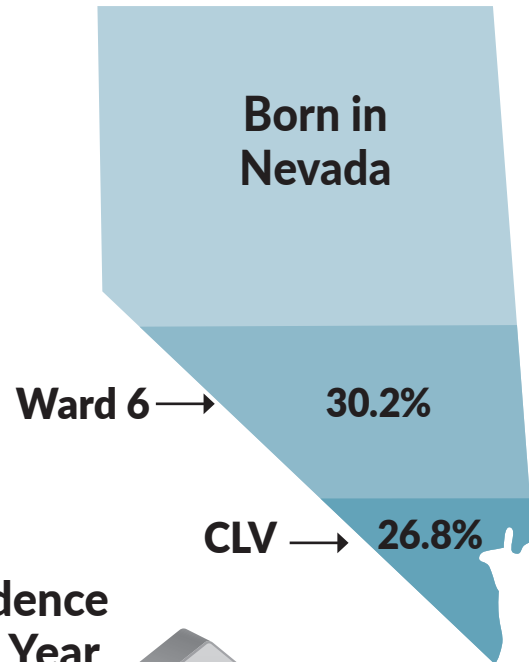
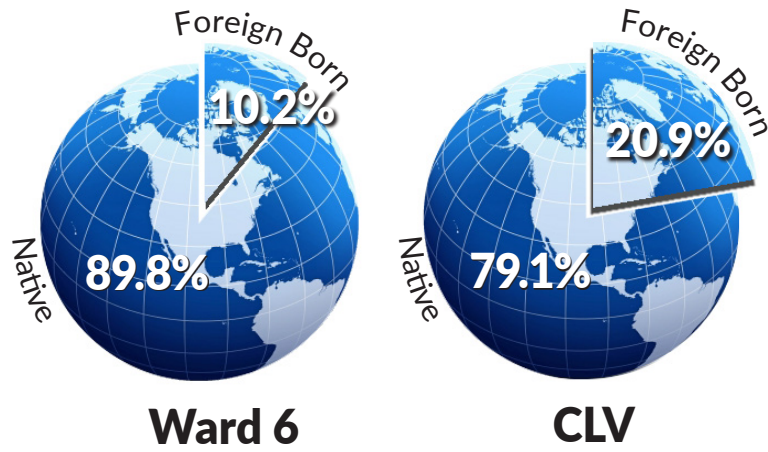
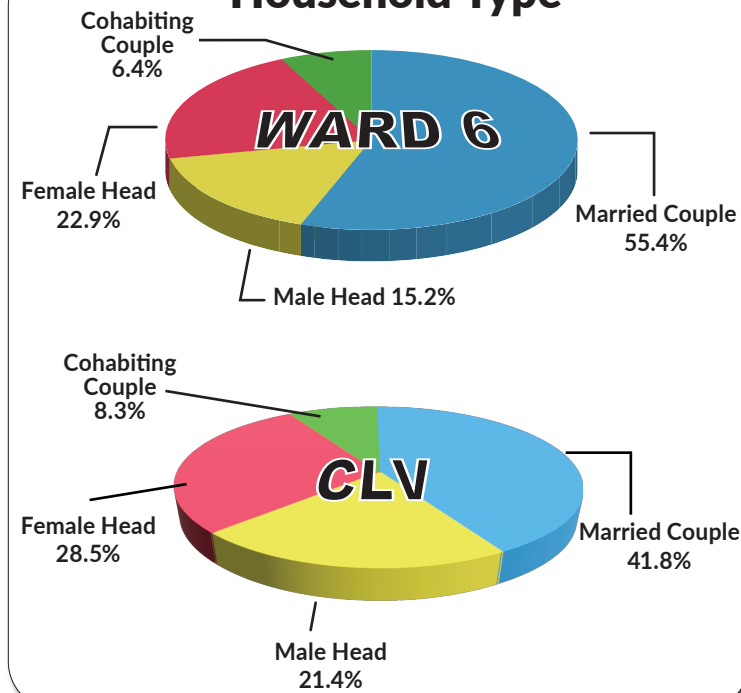




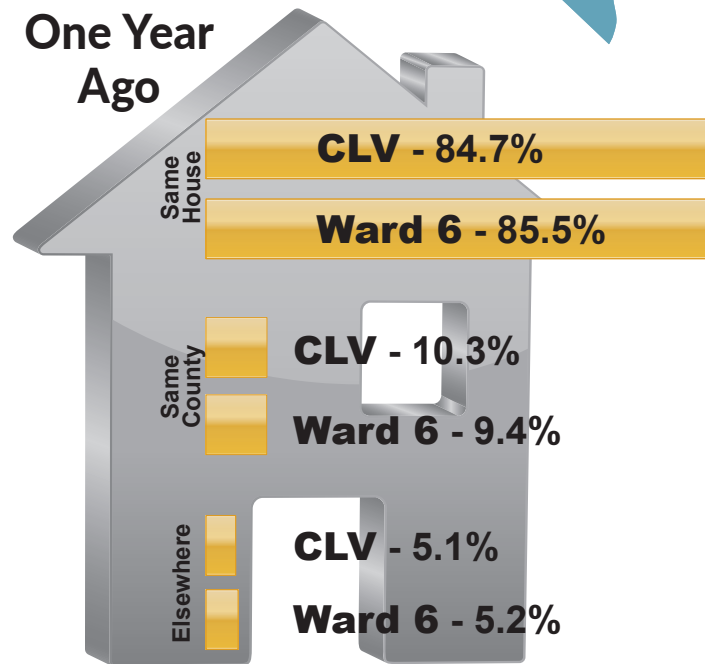
Nativity and Place of Birth



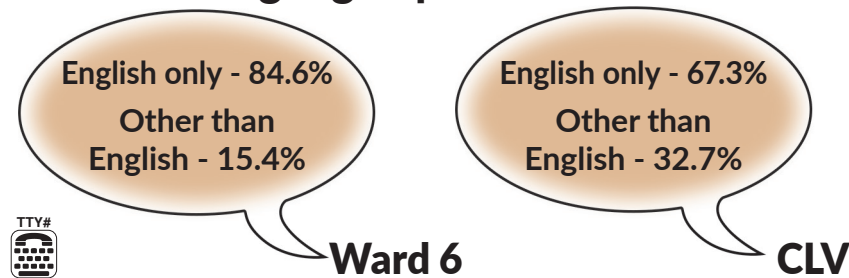

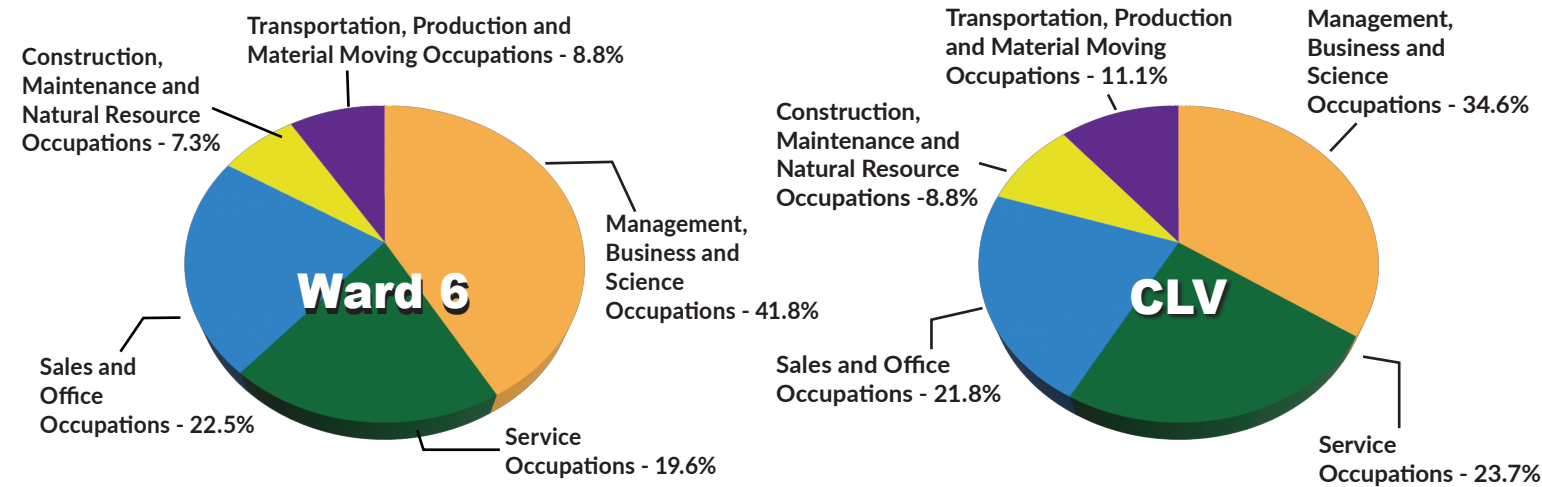
