- * On average, Las Vegas' population doubled every 7.9 years between 1910 and 1960.
- * Since 1960 the City's population has doubled on average every 19 years.
- * Overall, since 1910 the City's population has, on average, doubled every 12 years.
- * Between 1990 and 2000, Las Vegas added one new housing unit and 2.5 new residents per hour, around the clock
- * Since 2000, Las Vegas has added 1.0 new resident and 0.5 new housing units per hour, around the clock.
- * Since 1910 Las Vegas has averaged adding 6.0 new dwelling units and 16.5 new residents per day
- * Basically Las Vegas has added a 196 unit subdivision and 496 people every month since the 1910 Census.

- * Las Vegas is the most populous U.S. city incorporated during the 20th century.
- * Since the 2020 Census, Las Vegas' population has overtaken Boston, Detroit, and Portland.
- * Nevada has twice as many cities with 250,000 population or more (4) than the states of New York, New Jersey, and Pennsylvania and one more than Florida.
