City of Las Vegas – Number of Animals Permitted

7.08.140 - Number of dogs permitted.

Except as otherwise provided in Section 7.08.150, no person shall keep more than six dogs over three months of age, at any place, on any premises, or in any one residence, located within the City.

7.08.160 - Number of cats permitted.

Except as otherwise provided in Section 7.08.170, no person shall keep more than six cats over four months of age, at any place, or on any premises, or in any one residence, located within the City.

7.08.185 - Ferrets—Number limited.

No person shall keep more than four ferrets over four months of age at any residence or premises within the City.

7.38.060 - Rabbits—Number allowed.

Except as otherwise provided in this Title, no person shall keep more than four rabbits over four months of age at any place, on any premises, or in any one residence located within the City.

7.08.180 - Pet fancier's permit.

A pet fancier may own, keep or possess on his or her property not more than eight spayed or neutered dogs over one year of age or twelve spayed or neutered cats over eight months of age, or any combination thereof if the number of dogs does not exceed eight and the combined number of animals does not exceed twelve, provided that the pet fancier has obtained from the Animal Regulation Officer a pet fancier's permit.
